

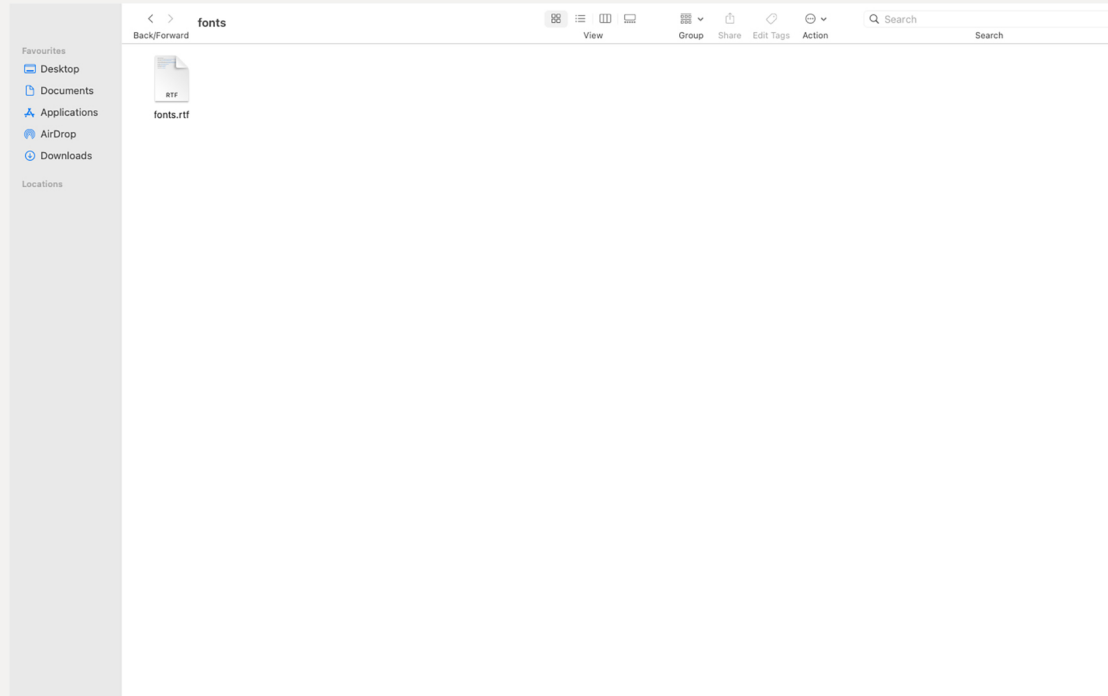

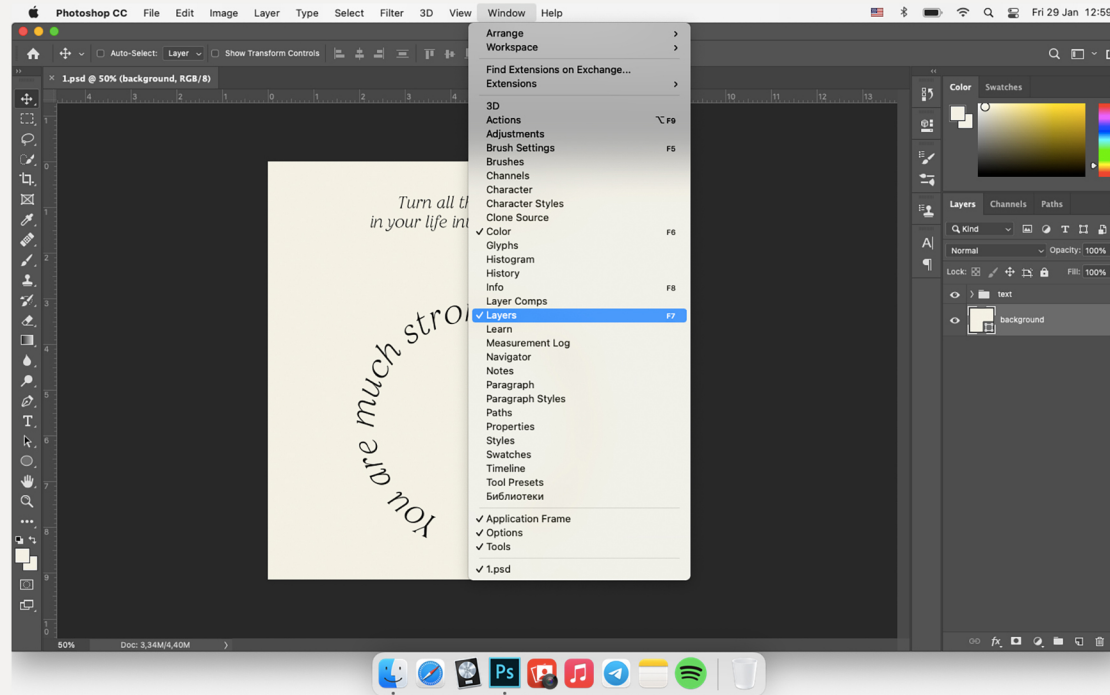

Layers Palette

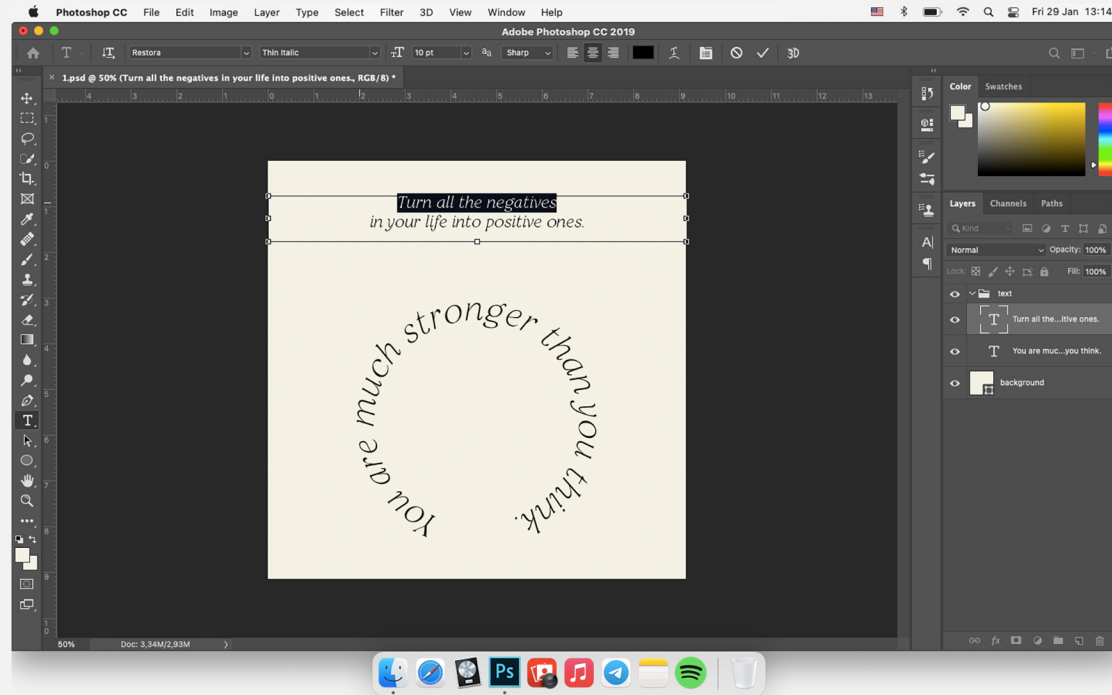
LOVE RADIATION



- The Layers palette in Photoshop lists all layers, layer groups, and layer effects in an image. You'll find the Layers palette in the lower right of the screen. If the layers palette is not visible, you can find it by going to Window>Layers in the menu bar and ensuring Layers is checked.
- To make the layers easy to navigate, we've divided them into clearly labelled folders. To expand the group, click the small arrow on the left hand side of the folder.

Editing Text

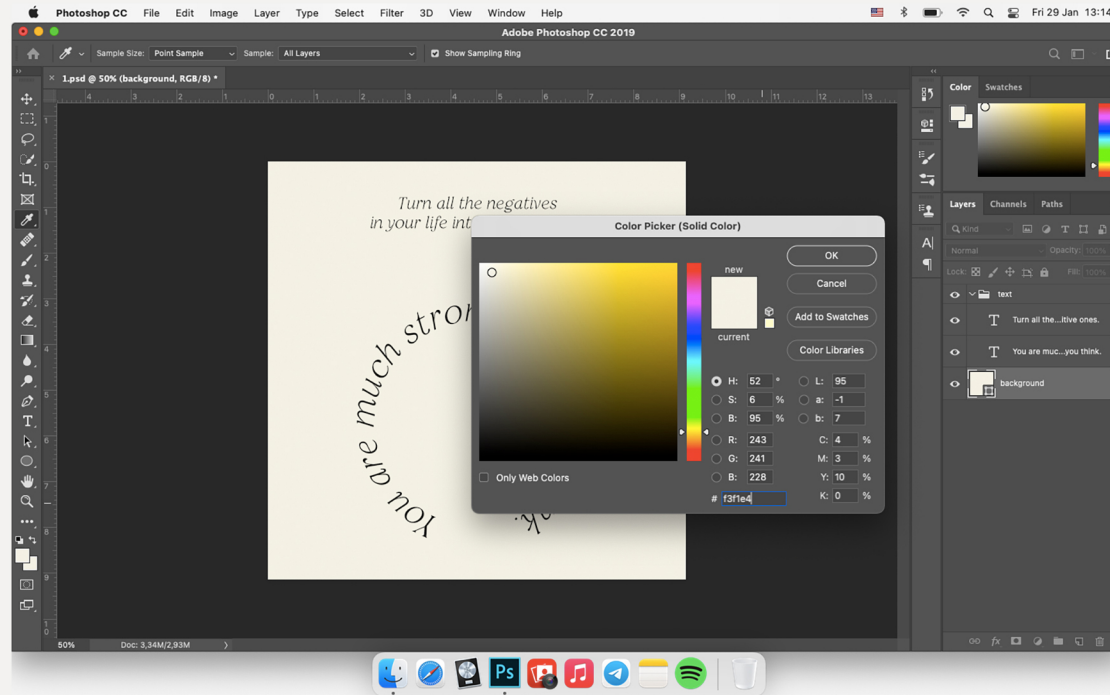

- Select the type tool in the tool panel Window>Tools.
- Navigate to the text you want to edit.
- Double click the text and highlight the words you want to edit.

Editing Color (Backgrounds)

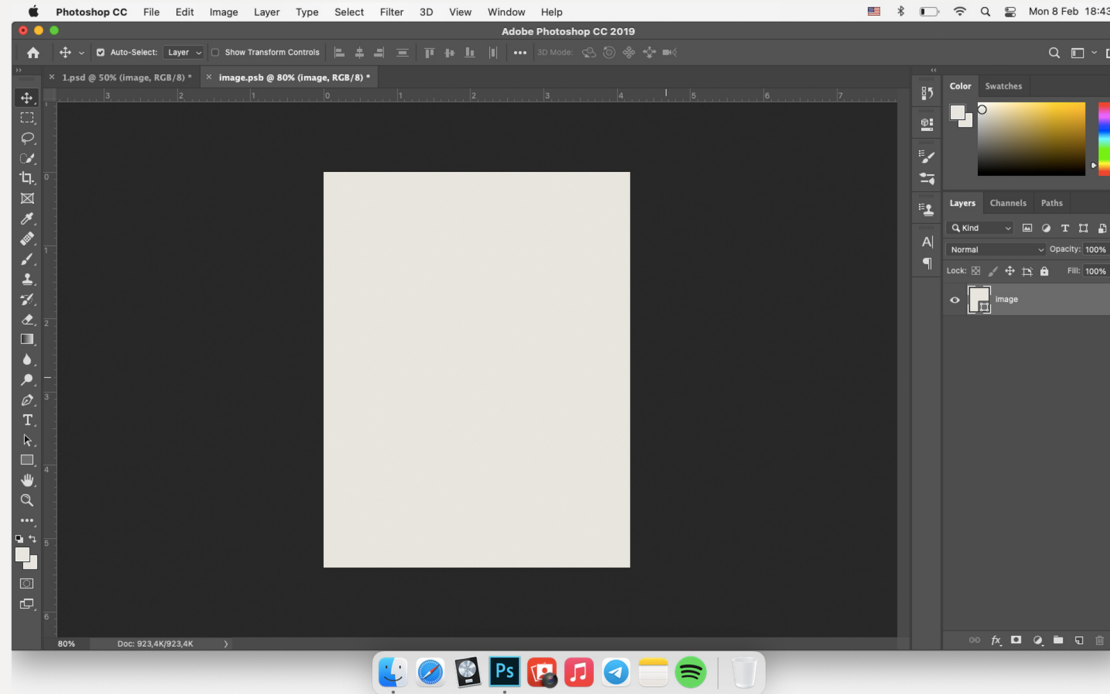

- Find the box in the layers palette and double click the small thumbnail next to the layer name.
- This will open the color selector. Choose the color you want.
- Click Ok.

Adding Images

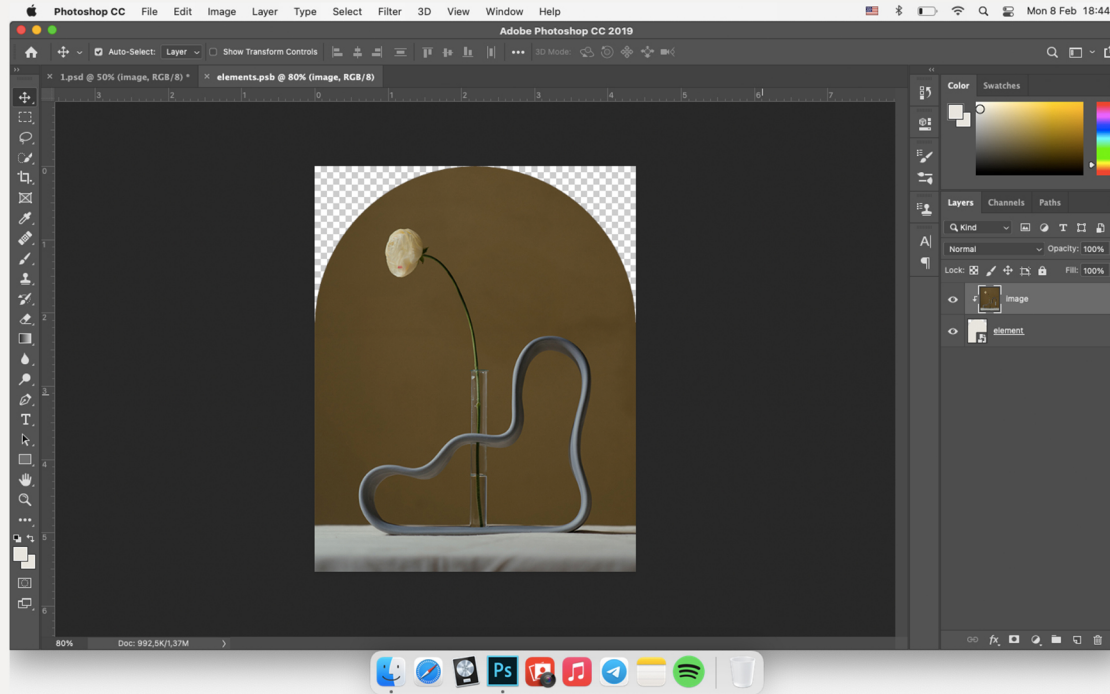

- To add an image you must first find the image layer and Double Click this layer. A new window will open.
- Place your image in this window by going to File>Place and selecting your image.

Adding Images (Abstract Shapes)

- Images are saved as smart layers in this template. this saves you from having to resize and scale your images to work within this template.
- To add an image you must first find the image layer and Double Click this layer. A new window will open.
- Place your image in this window by going to File>Place and selecting your image.
- Place your cursor between the layer of the image you added and the layer of the abstract element where you want to place your image and hold Alt + Click.
- Go to File>Save and close this window. (Your original window will be updated).

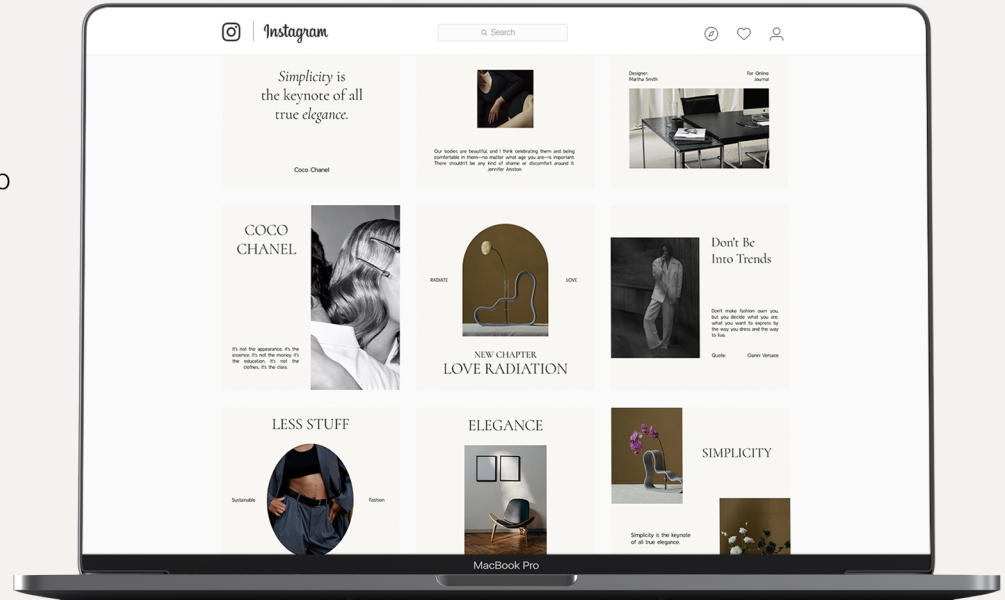
